


FUNNY FACES

TOP HALF

OF FACE


SHOULDERS


GET A SMALL BOOK OR JOIN A FEW SHEETS OF PAPER TOGETHER TO FORM A SMALL BOOK. DIVIDE THE FIRST PAGE INTO FOUR EQUAL SECTIONS BY PENCIL LINES. THEN MAKE FOUR PIN-HOLES THROUGH ALL OF THE PAGES TO SERVE AS AN OUTLINE FOR THE FACES.

THEN DRAW A FUNNY FACE ON EACH PAGE - DRAW THE HAT IN PART 1, EYES IN PART2, MOUTH IN PART 3 AND SHOULDERS IN PART 4. MAKE ALL OF THE FACES, HATS AND SHOULDERS DIFFERENT.


CUT THE SECTIONS AS SHOWN, LEAVING A MARGIN AT THE LEFT SO THE BOOK DOESN'T FALL APART. BY TURNING OVER THE SECTIONS YOU CAN EXPLORE MIXING ALL OF THE FACES. HATS AND SHOULDERS.
